Year 2 are learning about Living Things and their Habitats in Science. The children truly enjoyed completing their projects and models at home with their families of different habitats, and the plants and animals that live there. These habitats included: polar habitats, rainforests, deserts, oceans, ponds and woodland. They were happy to share with their teachers and classmates the facts they researched about living things and their habitats to go with their models.





Money Madness!



The children in Year 2 have been learning about money in Mathematics. They are able to recognise, describe and know the value of the different British coins and notes. They have been able to demonstrate how to combine monies to make different amounts while using the symbols for pounds (£) and pence (p).

They have enhanced their understanding of money concepts by finding different combinations of coins that equal the same amount of money. The children have shown great resilience in using their Mathematics skills to solve problems involving the addition and subtraction of money, including giving change.

Well done to the Year 2 children for their diligence in learning and demonstrating important mathematical skills whilst learning real-life skills.

MY-CATS is a research project which aims to test a new way of identifying and supporting children to help build confidence and minimise problems with anxiety, now and in the future. It involves parents, guardians and carers completing questionnaires to help us identify which children may be most likely to benefit from support, and then offering them online and telephone support. The support is designed to help parents, guardians and carers encourage their child to build confidence and to provide them with skills and strategies for the future.
