The children were thrilled to join in with the fundraising efforts for Red Nose Day on Friday 18th March. Celebrating in style with red accessories, Brookside was in true Red Nose Day spirit incorporating a plethora of fun, delightful and entertaining activities!









British Science Week

Last week, the children enthusiastically celebrated British Science Week under the theme 'Growth'. Nursery pupils learnt about the lifecycles of animals and humans; Year 1 pupils planted a variety of seeds and bulbs; Year 3 pupils created paper origami to represent various antibodies and viruses, and Year 5 pupils used clay and playdough to create aliens living on Mars. The week featured fascinating activities across the School, making core curriculum topics more engaging and stimulating scientific learning among the children.









'Egg-citing' Experiment

On Monday 21st March, Year 4 pupils took part in an 'egg-citing' tooth decay experiment using eggshells to represent tooth enamel, observing the effect liquids such as Coke, milk, orange juice and apple juice have on their teeth. The children discovered that each of the experiment variations demonstrated the potential for tooth decay from discolouration and weakening to demineralisation, emphasising the importance of healthy food choices and a balanced diet.





Virtual Asthma Workshop
