

Mental Health Awareness Week - Monday 9th to Sunday 15th May

Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check Workshop -

Wednesday 18th May

The Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) is statutory for primary schools in the 2021/22 academic year. The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in Mathematics. It helps schools to identify pupils who have not yet mastered their times tables, so that additional support can be provided. We will be administering the MTC to all eligible Year 4 pupils between Monday 6th and Friday 24th June. To guide and support the parents, guardians and carers further, Year 4 teachers will be running a workshop about MTC on Wednesday 18th May at 9:00am.
