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Developing Fine Motor Skills in Nursery

Our Nursery children enjoyed playing with shaving foam last week. They used a range of equipment for mark-making, such as spoons, brushes and rollers to explore different textures. This allowed them to practise their fine motor skills and coordination, whilst being imaginative and following instructions.

Our children were also encouraged to be descriptive with sensory details in their conversations with their teachers and teaching partners during their outdoor play. They were amazing at turn taking and sharing the toys with their peers.













Year 1 Science Tree Hunt

On Wednesday 15th June, Year 1 pupils were outside in the sunny weather observing tree leaves as part of their Science lesson. This involved observing the leaves carefully to identify the different species of trees we are lucky enough to have on our school grounds.

The children in Helsinki and Stockholm learned how to be respectful to plants and the living creatures in our local area through carefully touching the trees and learning their names. In addition, the pupils made links between seasonal changes they have observed so far this year and how deciduous trees change as a result.



Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check

Over the course of last week, the Year 4 children undertook their Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check [MTC], which is a statutory assessment for all Year 4 children.

The staff at Brookside would like to congratulate them for their resilience, as they received a limited window of 6 seconds to answer each question. Overall, each child answered 25 questions. During the trial period, some children showed significant improvement and we are proud of all their efforts! Thank you to our Year 4 teachers for adequately preparing our children for this assessment.
