

Year 6 Movie Day

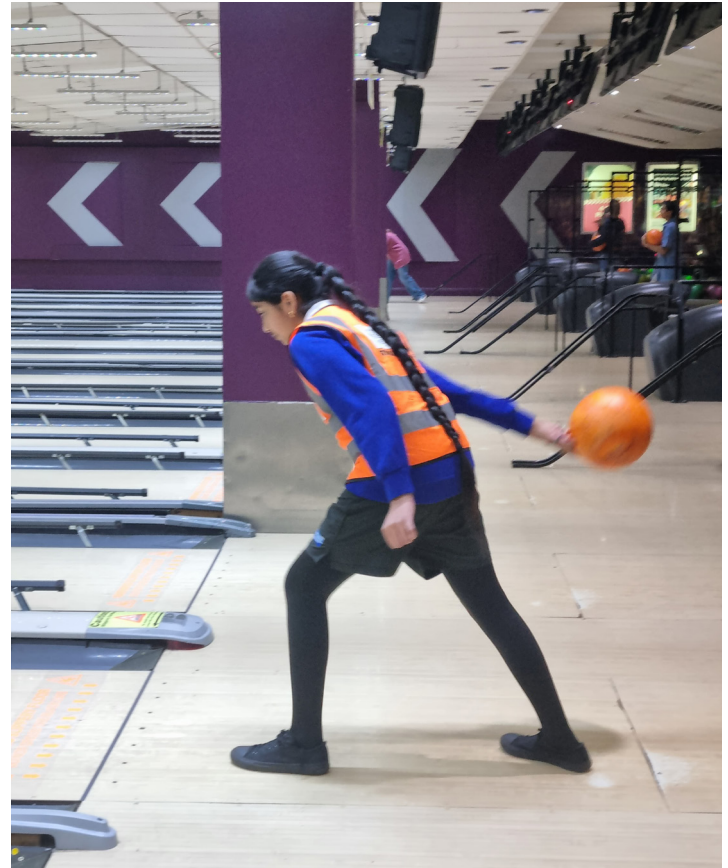
