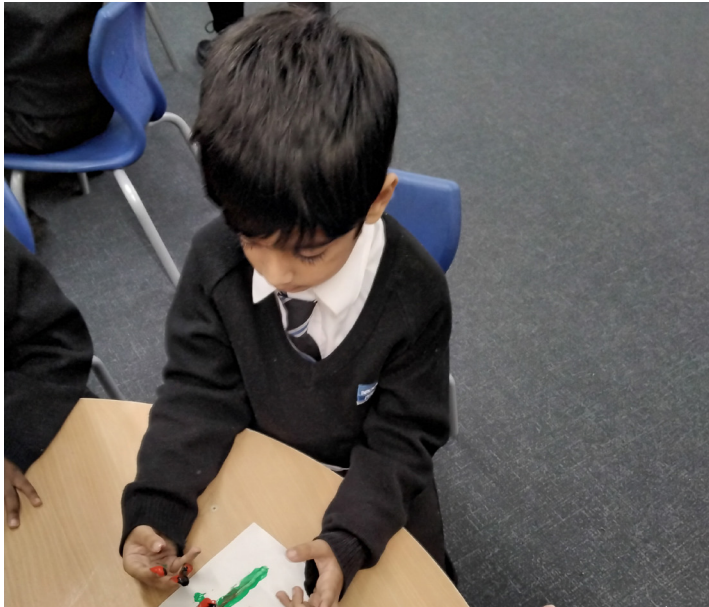


Remembrance Day

Year 4 New Delhi Parent, Guardian, Carer Asseembly


