




Pupils in Year 5 Key Stage 2

Year 5 pupils are learning about the history of Tudor portraits. They are learning the skill of using colours and patterns creating Henry VIII"s portrait. Portraits were a symbol of health and wealth during Tudor times, and pupils were able to connect their history and art learning.





Art and the Stone Age

For Design and Technology, Year 3 have been creating 3D art in the form of Stone Age pottery. This is linked to our history topic on the 'Stone Age to Iron Age', where the pots would be used for many things including holding food and precious items. Children used a simple 'pinch-pot' or 'thumb pot' technique to create their pots. They carefully formed the clay into a ball and then inserted their thumb into the centre, where they could then begin to pinch the pot between their thumb and fingers to widen the clay into a bowl shape. Some very lovely pots were created! See for yourself.
