## Reading with your Children

Reading books aloud to children stimulates their imagination. It helps them develop language and listening skills and prepares them to understand the written words. With this in mind, we urge all parents, guardians and carers to share a book with your children at bedtime. ## Stay and Read

Parents, Guardians and Carers, you are invited to a reading workshop where teachers will model the expectations of reading at home. As parents, guardians and carers you will be required to sit with your child, read through and be shown how you can question and complete the reading records. Teachers will ao through rande а comprehension strategies that can be used at home, as well as, additional links for supporting reading.

#### **Booster and Fun Clubs**
