

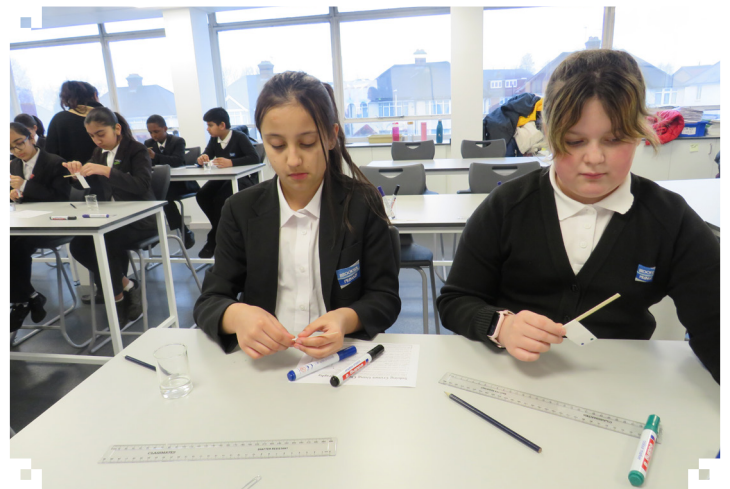
### Science Year 4.

In Science, Year 4 pupils have been exploring different diets of animals through the study of their teeth. They can name various types of teeth and their function, understanding why certain animals, like herbivores, don't have certain types of teeth. In addition, children from Year 4 have been participating in conducting some experiments to comprehend the importance of taking care of our teeth and how. In this experiment, pupils used eggs to investigate which liquids would influence tooth decay. They understood that they could use eggs for this investigation as their shell has the same materials as the enamel on our teeth. This week, pupils will have the chance to conclude their experiment and write down the effects of the various liquids.



### National Career Week.

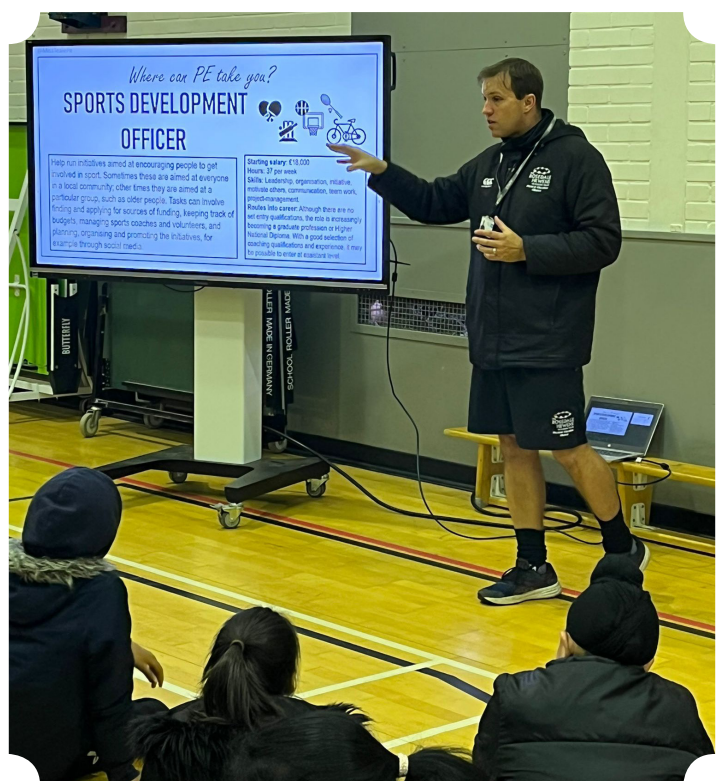
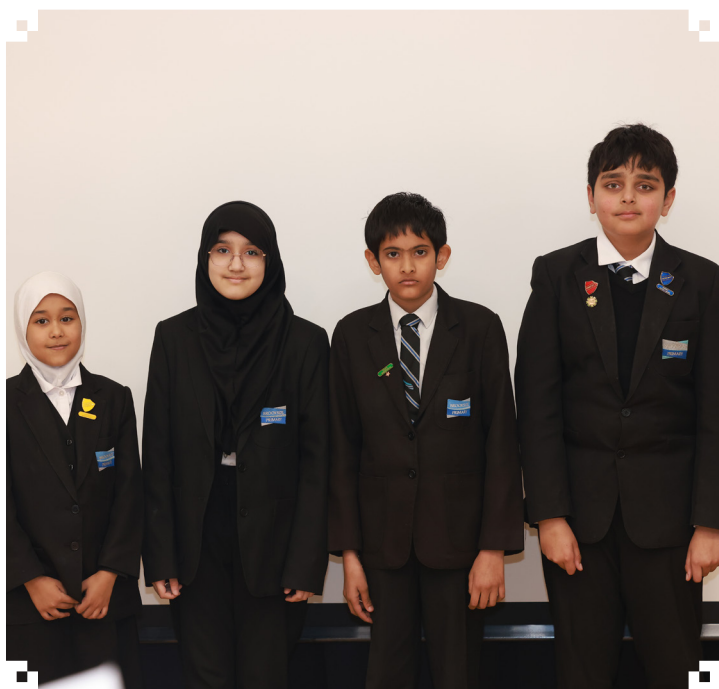

In Year 1, pupils planted sunflower seeds! They have been learning about how to write their own instructions that include time conjunctions and imperative verbs. As a class, we wrote instructions together and then the children followed the steps to plant their seeds. You can use their instructions to plant your own seed! How to plant a seed

1. First get your materials - soil, seeds, pot and water.
2. Next put soil in the pot.
3. Then put the seed into the soil.
4. After that you put the pot in the sun.
5. Lastly you water your seed.

As their seeds begin to sprout and grow into wonderful flowers, this will help prepare them for their upcoming Science topic on plants!

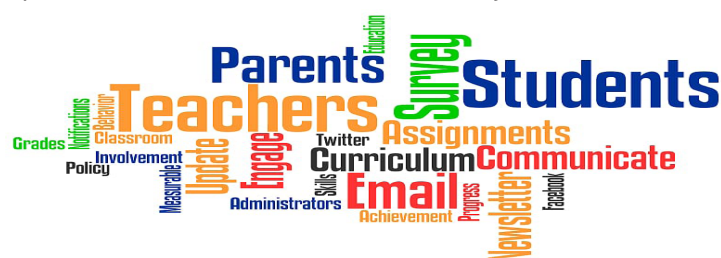
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## Labelled Water Bottles
