






Happy Diwali!



Year 6 SATs Workshop

On **Thursday 9th November**, the **Year 6** parents were invited to a **SATs Workshop**. It was amazing to see so many parents attend this important presentation. The workshop informed them about the structure of the SATs Exam. This included what is being tested and the dates in which SATs will take place. As part of the presentation, parents got an opportunity to see the types of questions that the children will have to face, how they can help support their child at home and an information pack to take away. **SATs** for this academic year take place during the week beginning the **13th May 2024**.



Years 5 and 6 Debate

As part of **UK Parliament Week**, both **Year 5** and **6** took part in a Debate competition on **Friday 10th November**. The debating topics were as follows: **Technology in the future will cause more problems than solutions- (Year 6)**; and **Technology will diminish social interactions and reduce human activities - (Year 5)**. Both years 5 and 6 had three children debating in each team. For each team, the 1st speaker opened the view for the debate, 2nd speaker went on to further back the view and the 3rd speaker was responsible for the rebuttal (responding to any opposing arguments that might undermine their argument). The children each had 5 minutes to present their points.

It was amazing to see the children flourish and present their points in a clear and articulate way. We are very proud of them.

Visit to the Hounslow Jamia Masjid- Thursday, 23rd and Tuesday, 28th November 2023

The **Year 2 children** are learning about the **Islamic religion** in their Religious Education lessons. They will be visiting and touring the **Hounslow Jamia Masjid & Islamic Centre** to consolidate their learning about the Islamic place of worship, their practices, beliefs and celebrations. They will be able to use this hands-on experience to make comparisons with other religious practices they will be learning about further in the school year along with their own. **Year 2 Kiev will be visiting on Thursday, 23rd November and Year 2 Ankara will go on Tuesday, 28th November 2023.**



Year 4 Trip to Sea life Aquarium London- Friday, 24th November 2023

The children in **Year 4** have been learning about different habitats and animals during Science lessons. To consolidate what they have learnt, they will be going to the **Sea Life Aquarium** on **Friday, 24th November 2023**. At the Aquarium, children will see oceanic animals in their habitats. This experience will broaden their learning and their understanding of underwater animals and their environments. They will be able to point out the difference between mammals and fish. We hope this experience will give the pupils a better understanding of their scientific learning. The children will leaving school no later than 9:00 a.m., therefore they will need to arrive on time and no later than 8:45 a.m. **The children should be wearing their full and correct uniform and come with their labelled packed lunch and water bottle for the day.** They will arrive back in time for normal dismissal. Year 2 Great Plague and Great Fire of London- Monday, 27th November 2023

On **Monday, 27th November 2023**, children in **Year 2** will be travelling back in time to Restoration Britain and will in activities that immerse them in history. They will re-enact the events from the **Great Fire of London and the Black Death** in a workshop hosted by the Crew Company and commemorate this 'small mistake, but with great consequences' in 17th century London through a combination of drama and role-play.

Prehistory Workshop- Tuesday, 28th November 2023

Year 3 children will travel back in time to learn about the **Stone Age to the Iron Age period**. They will learn more about how people lived during the Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic periods and the changes that happened during the Bronze and Iron Age. The children will get a chance to see artefacts such as spears, axes and other tools. We hope that this will be a great experience which help to bring the children's learning about this key part of history to life!
