

## Bollywood Dancers

In **Early Years**, the children participated in an **Indian Bollywood Dance Workshop** on **Friday 17th November** where they learnt dance moves whilst listening to classic Bollywood songs. The children then performed their dance moves for the Year 1 and 2 children. The music and dance also reflected on the story of Rahma and Sita. This workshop enhanced their learning as they have been learning about different celebrations in the topic **Understanding the World**.



## Learning in London

In **Phonics**, the **Nursery** children learned the 'n' sound. They then expounded on writing the letter that makes that sound on their whiteboard to aid in developing their fine motor skills. They also used the skewers by bending them to form the letters on their whiteboards and used their fingers to write the letter on sand trays. In **Mathematics**, the children learned to count each teddy while placing them on their plates correctly. This will aid in children associating an amount with the correct numeral. They further explored this concept by counting each food item and placing them on each teddy's plate.

### **Year 2 Great Plague and Great Fire of London-** *Monday, 27th November 2023*


On **Monday, 27th November 2023**, children in **Year 2** will be travelling back in time to Restoration Britain and will in activities that immerse them in history.
