

**Victorian Seaside**

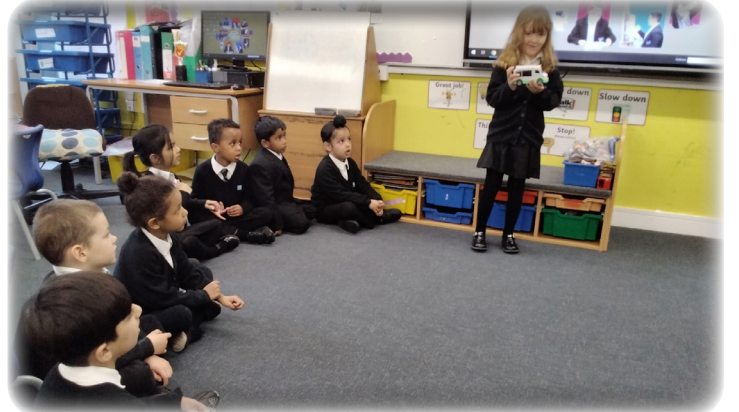

### People who help us- Our Community Helpers

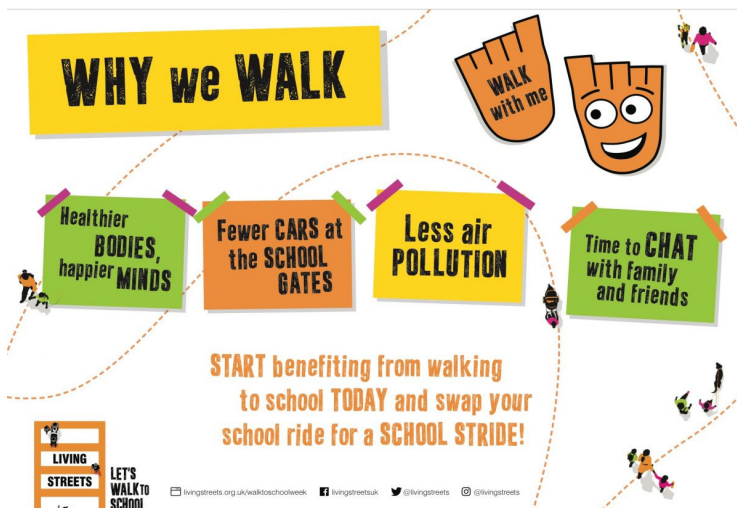
