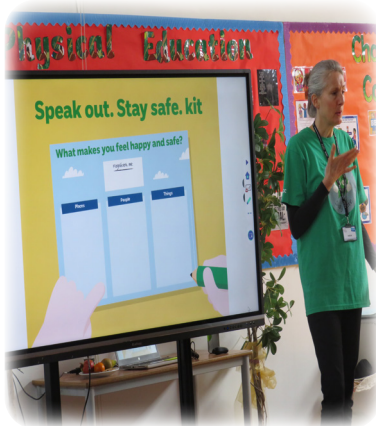
Nursery's "Crafternoon"

NSPCC Workshop

For Mental Health and Awareness Week, Monday, 13th-17th May, our pupils were presented with some fun and interesting information via different forums thanks to the NSPCC (National Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children). Early Years learnt about the PANTS Rules and understand the importance of consent & their right to say no. Years 1 to 6 examined how we should Speak out and Stay Safe. The sessions helped pupils understand abuse in all its forms, including bullying; how to protect themselves and to make them aware of how to get help and the sources of help available to them, including Childline. They found the sessions engaging, especially when they met Buddy.



Rainforest Troopers

The Year 3 pupils learned about tropical rainforests in their Geography lessons and thoroughly enjoyed the topic. It allowed them to take vicarious adventures into the Amazon rainforest, learning about the cultures of various tribes and exploring the exotic plants and animals there. Class 3 Brasilia took their learning to the next level by performing an impressive assembly. They shared facts about the rainforest and raised awareness about the harmful effects of deforestation. It was wonderful to see and hear how confidently the remarkable Class Brasilia tribe spoke and sang in front of a large audience of proud parents and supportive schoolmates—well done, Class Brasilia!
