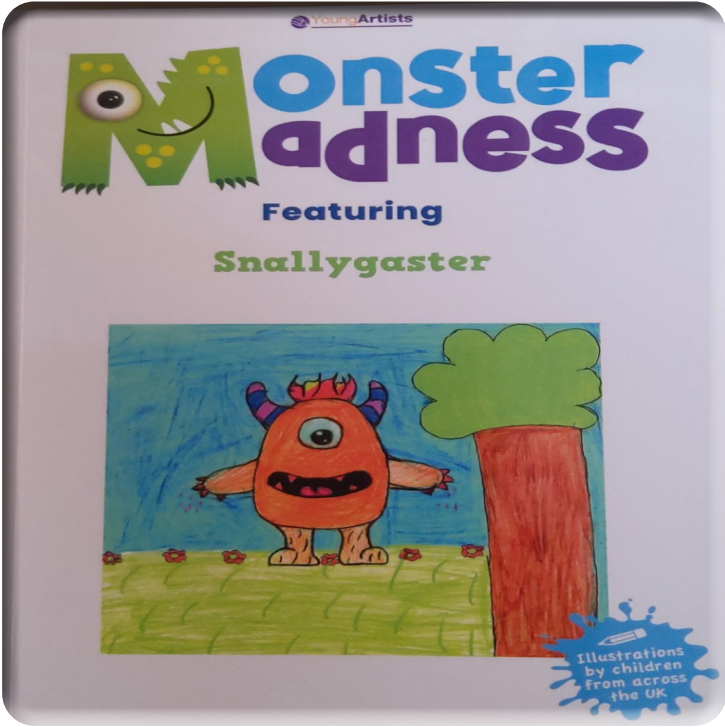


Young Artists

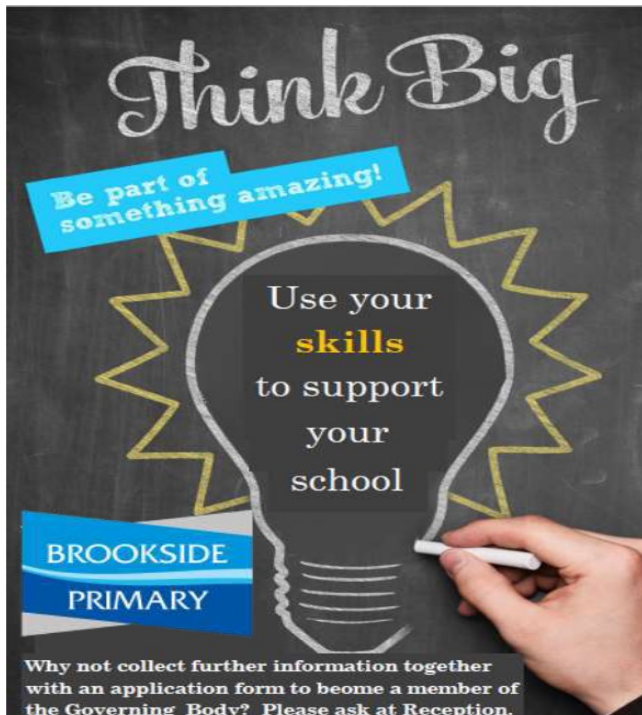
