# Daylight Savings SAFETY PLANS...

Pupils and their parents are reminded that in order to maximise their safety on their journeys to and from school we would recommend: Where possible students walk/travel in pairs or groups to and from school. Walk down main roads/routes that are well lit. Avoid going through parks, alleys or other unlit or poorly lit areas. Ensure they are alert to the environment around them, avoid wearing headphones or being distracted by mobile phones and other devices.
