



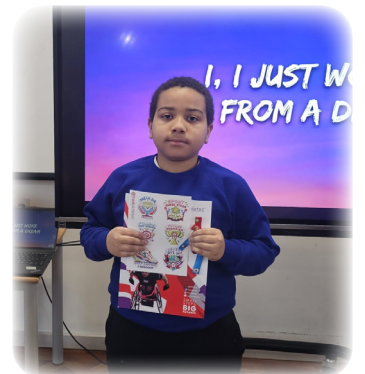
Practical Pedestrian Training
