



## Books, Bonding, and Big Smiles

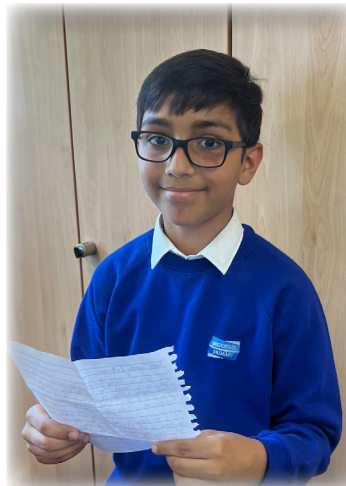
