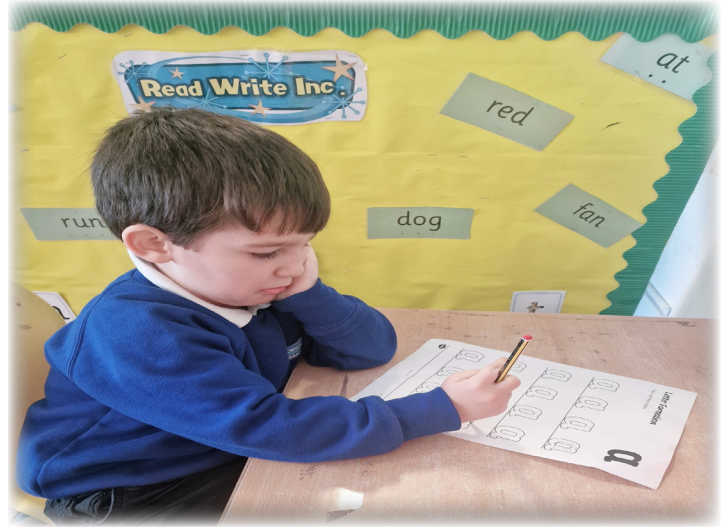




Nursery Learning

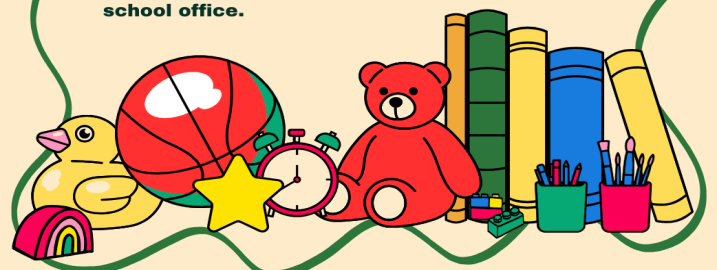
