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Science - What's Living in our Local Habitat?

For the Autumn Term, pupils in Year 1 are exploring the following topics: Seasons and Animals, including Humans. On Wednesday 23rd September, Stockholm pupils gathered in the School field armed with clipboards to identify the varying species of animals living in the local area. A fun, practical activity was incorporated into their Science lesson as the children were tasked with presenting their weather reports to their peers after a representational role play as mini meteorologists!

Applying for Secondary School September 2021

We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of children born between 1st September 2009 and 31st August 2010 that the closing date for applications for Secondary School places to be received by the London Borough of Hillingdon, by post or online, is **Saturday 31st October 2020.** To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications no later than Friday 23rd October to ensure that it is received by the published deadline. You will receive information with regard to applying for your child starting secondary school shortly.

Primary School Admissions 2021

We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of children born between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017 that the closing date for applications for Primary School places to be received by the London Borough of Hillingdon, by post or online, is midnight on Friday 15th January 2021. To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications prior to the Christmas holiday period. The London Borough of Hillingdon states on their website that they cannot be held responsible for any delays in applications due to problems with postal or Internet service providers. School Lunches

Over the summer holidays, we had launched our new cashless system - iPayimpact, where parents, guardians and carers were each given a unique reference code via letter to set up their children's accounts. Registration must be completed in order to make payments online. You may have noticed that individual lunch prices have changed to £2.40 per day (£12.00 for the week). We would like to encourage parents, guardians and carers to pre-order their child's lunch for the week; this includes all children in receipt of free school meals, either selecting packed lunch or the School dinner choice of that day (Halal, Non-Halal or Vegetarian). You can select meals for seven weeks therefore avoiding logging in weekly. The lunch option will be displayed on the iPay account in case you are unsure of what is being served for that day. Parents, guardians and carers of children in Reception and Years 1 and 2 must pre-order meals online weekly. We would like to thank all families that have already registered their account. Face Masks
