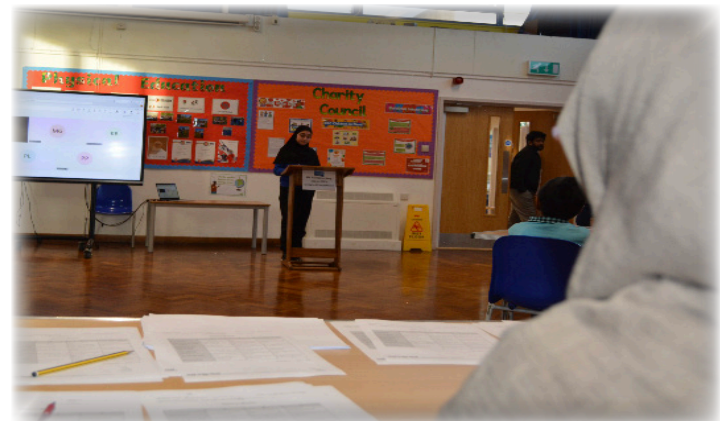


UK Parliament Week and Pupil Voice Week

As part of UK Parliament Week and Pupil Voice Week, our pupils had fantastic opportunities to engage in thoughtful discussions and structured debates. KS2 pupils explored a range of “big questions”, including “Animals should not be kept in zoos” and “Technology in the future will cause more problems than it will solve.” Working in teams, they presented confident arguments both for and against each statement, demonstrating critical thinking, excellent speaking skills, and respectful listening. Their debates were scored overall, and pupils showed maturity, enthusiasm, and a strong understanding of how democratic dialogue works. Our Year 1 pupils also took part by holding their own class debates, practising turn-taking, sharing ideas, and learning how to express opinions in a supportive environment. It was a wonderful week celebrating pupil voice, confidence, and the values of democracy across the school.

Science in Action

In Year 3, the pupils investigated the properties of three different types of rocks through a hands-on science experiment. To test hardness, they gently attempted to scratch each rock with a screw to see which surface marked most easily. They then placed the rocks in water to observe whether they floated or sank. Finally, the children added a small amount of acid to each rock to look for reactions such as fizzing or bubbling. Through these engaging tests, the pupils made careful observations and compared the unique properties of each rock, developing both their scientific understanding and their enquiry skills.
