## Early May Bank Holiday - Monday 4th May 2026

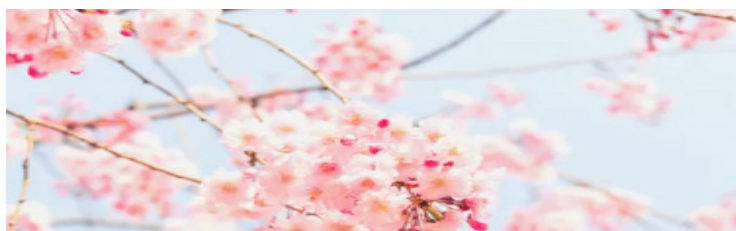
