Multiplication Tables Check – Year 4

Up until Friday 12th June, the Year 4 pupils will be taking their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) at school. The MTC is a Key Stage 2 assessment to be taken by pupils at the end of Year 4 in June. It is an online test where children are asked 25 questions on times tables from 2 to 12. For every question, pupils will have 6 seconds to answer, and in between the questions, there is a 3-second rest. Questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times tables come up more often. The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC. The purpose of the MTC is to ensure pupils' times tables knowledge is at the expected level. Parents, guardians and carers are being asked to ensure that the children practise on Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) which will be of great benefit in preparing them for the Multiplication Tables Check. We suggest practising 10 to 15 minutes a day for optimal results. Good luck!

Letters were sent out on Friday 24th April and must be returned to the school office by Monday 28th April.
