



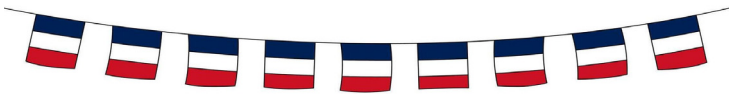
### A Trip to the Countryside
