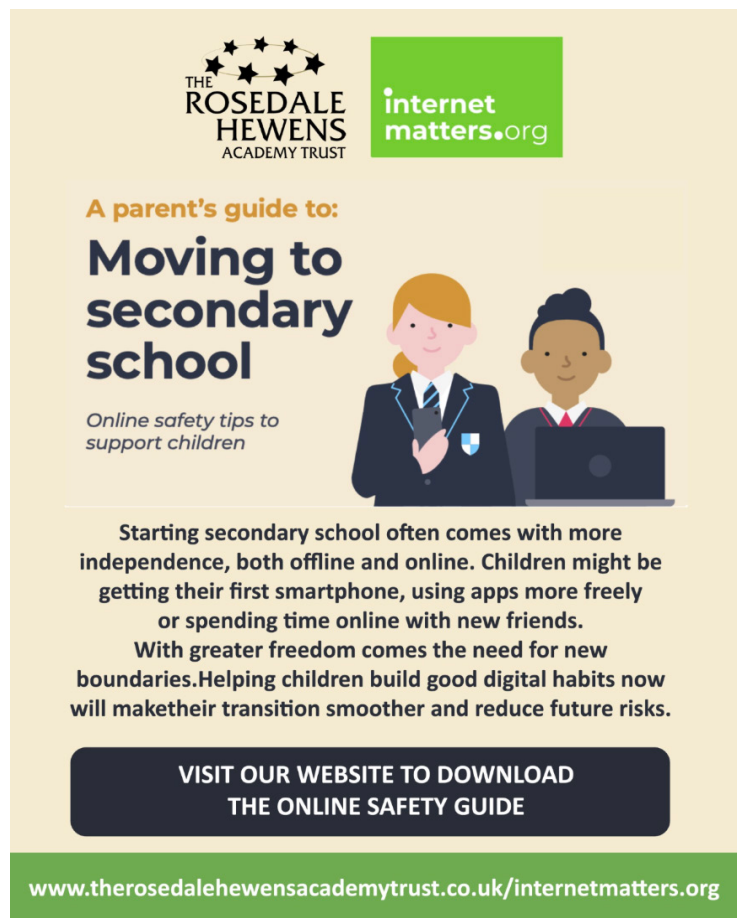
Enriching Wraparound Care Sessions!
