#### Let's Find some Invertebrates

Year 4 New Delhi and Kuala Lumpur, went on a playground excursion for their science lesson on Wednesday 25th November, to explore different types of invertebrate creatures that might exist in our local environment. In groups, pupils found snails, centipedes, spiders and many tinier creatures living in the soil, under rocks and other greenery. The class then went on to make a list of the species and describe their characteristics. The lesson was all encompassing, from identifying species, to highlighting characteristics and learning about their food intake and local habitat, and how animals seemed to be able to adapt to their environment.



## Hearing and Vision Screening

On Monday 14th December, the School nurses will be visiting the School to undertake a Hearing and Vision Screening for all Reception children. The local Nursing Team will carry out the tests in a private area. The team will also test your child's vision. The screening will seem more like a game to the children and nothing will touch their eyes.

If your child wears glasses, they will not have their vision tested. If they are receiving treatment for a hearing problem or wear hearing aids, they will not have their hearing tested. If you have any questions in relation to the tests, please contact the School office.
