#### Government Guidelines for Coronavirus

The government advises that capacity on public transport remains limited given the requirements for social distancing. This will be particularly challenging for children who travel to school via public transport.

As such, please encourage your child to walk or cycle to school where possible. Where this is not an option, we would like to reiterate the importance of parents, guardians and carers wearing face coverings on public transport for the duration of the journey, and for all to observe social distancing guidelines. Additionally, as confined spaces and limited ventilation on public transport can pose a risk to passengers, windows should also be kept open at all times to prevent the spread of coronavirus.

The current government guidance states that anyone who has coronavirus symptoms such as a new continuous cough, a high temperature, a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell, should stay at home. Thus, we urge all parents, guardians and carers to adhere to government guidelines and follow best practices by keeping their child at home if they are displaying symptoms, in an attempt to reduce the risk of transmission. We thank you for your cooperation in this matter.

### **Face Masks**

We kindly ask all parents, guardians and carers to wear face masks whilst onsite and adhere to the start and end times so we remain compliant with government guidelines for COVID-19. Please arrive at your allocated time slot in the New Year so we are able to ensure that children remain in their respective bubbles. Please note, we will only allow one adult to drop and collect children to minimise numbers. ## **Holiday Requests**

School holidays will not be approved during term. Any holidays taken during this period will be marked as unauthorised holiday. Parents, guardians and carers, please remember the importance of factoring any potential quarantine restrictions into your holiday, so that if any quarantine measures are required, these do not impact on your child's return to school in January. The Christmas Holidays are only two weeks long and, in most cases, you may have to quarantine for 14 days when you travel to a country and when you return to the United Kingdom. The Department for Education [DfE] guidance states that school attendance is mandatory so all absences will be referred and logged as unauthorised. Any term time holiday requests must be sent to the Headteacher in writing at least one month prior to travelling and before securing any travel arrangements.

### **Primary School Admissions 2021**

We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of children born between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017 that the closing date for applications for Primary School places to be received by the London Borough of Hillingdon, by post or online, is midnight on Friday 15th January 2021. To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications prior to the Christmas holiday period. The London Borough of Hillingdon states on their website that they cannot be held responsible for any delays in applications due to problems with postal or Internet service providers.
