




# Three-Dimensional (3D) Shapes

Year 4 engaged in a creative Mathematics lesson, assembling three-dimensional (3D) shapes using net and wire mesh. Pupils in class have been investigating the properties of 3D shapes by putting them together and comparing their construction. They then went on to analyse the shapes, covering the different faces, edges and vertices of each shape, building upon their knowledge whilst developing important mathematic skills.





#### **British Science Week**

As Year 6 have been learning about Evolution and Inheritance, they were tasked to create their own fossils using toy animals and clay. They learnt that palaeontologists study fossils and that fossils can be used to identify how tall or big an animal was, and how they are used to identify periods in time when these animals were alive.
