

Under The Sea

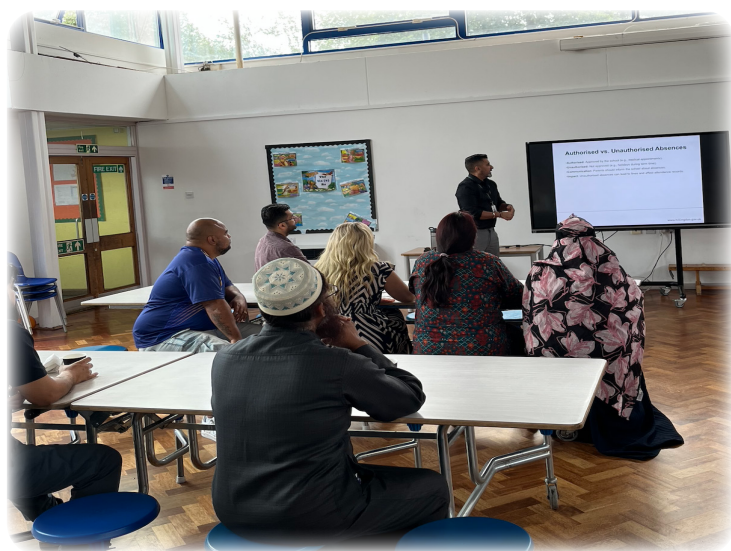
