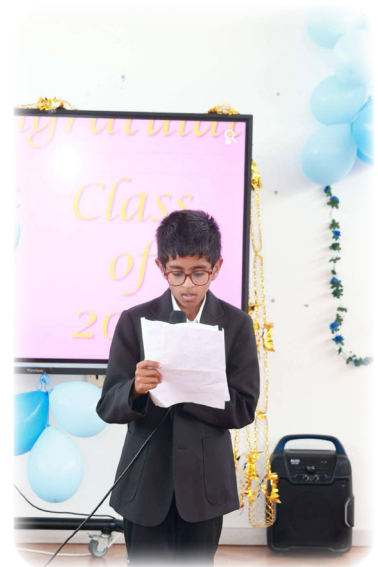


Graduation

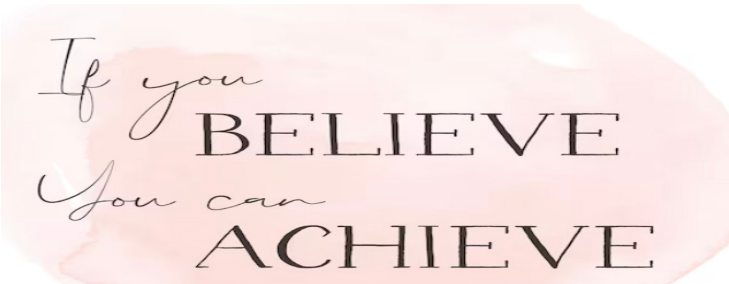
