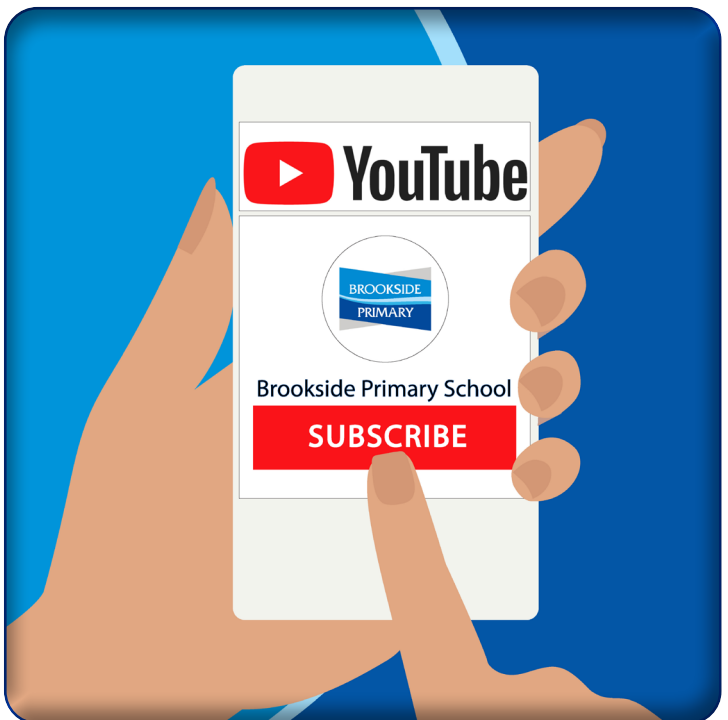
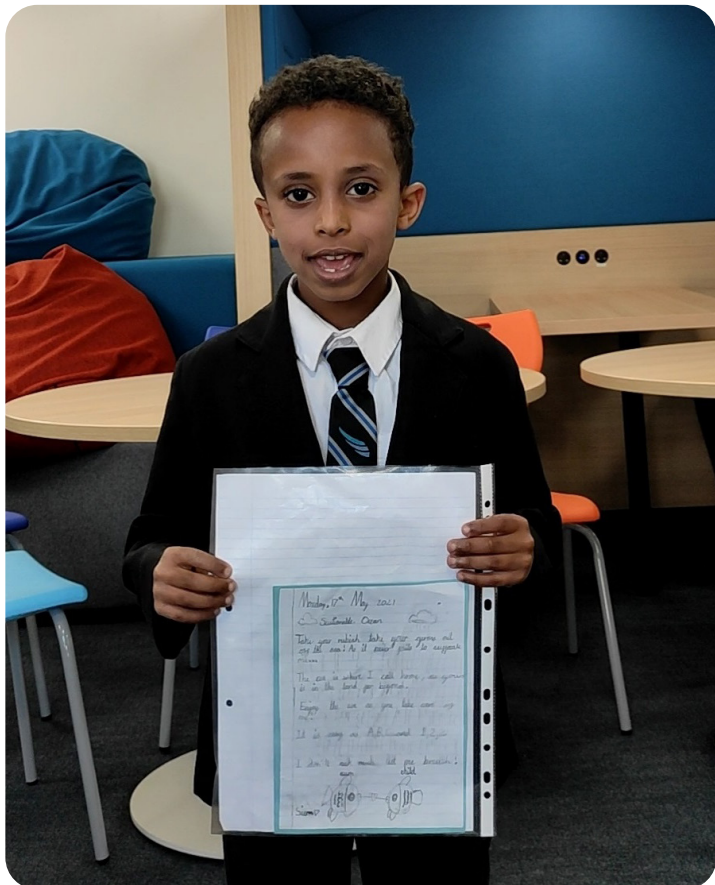


Poetic Poets

Conjunctivitis

Conjunctivitis is a common eye infection that affects children. It can be caused by either an infection or an allergy and is contagious. If your child is showing signs of conjunctivitis or if you believe your child's infection is bacterial, it is prudent to visit your child's paediatrician to determine whether they need drops.

Symptoms can range from watery eyes to discharge in one or both eyes. If your child is experiencing either of the above, please ensure that they are kept at home until the discharge from the eyes has cleared to prevent the infection from spreading to others. It is crucial that you also notify the School of their reason for absence.

Please continue to reiterate the importance of hand hygiene and encourage your child to wash their hands thoroughly and regularly throughout the day.
