

States of Matter



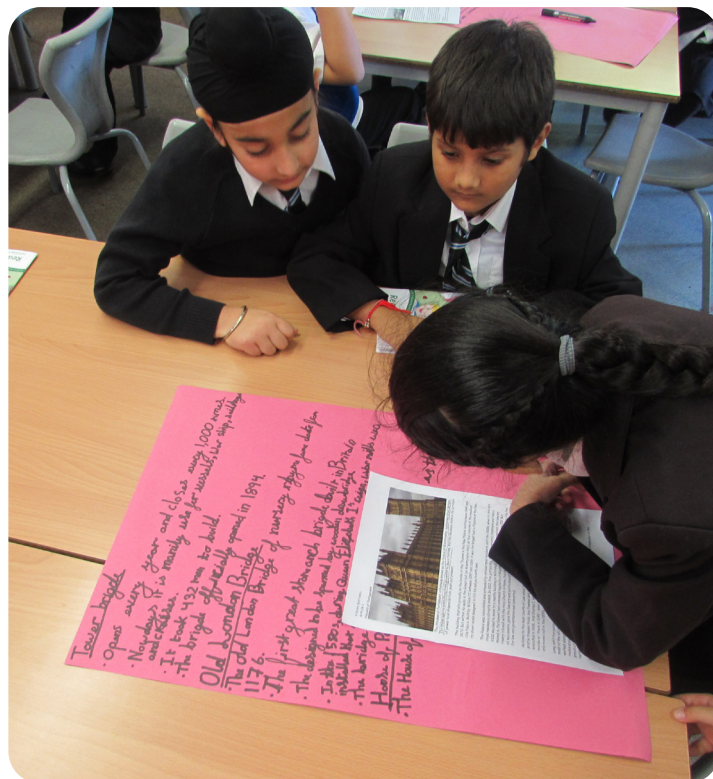

If you believe your child may be newly entitled to this benefit, or if they received it last year and you would like to reapply, **please attend the School Office and request an application form.**

The Free School Meals benefit does not automatically renew; it must be reapplied for each academic year.
